The position will be paid according to the TV-L 13 salary scale. The appointment is initially for two years with the option to extend the contract.

Successful candidates are expected to hold a Ph.D. in economics, applied or agricultural economics, and to have a strong quantitative analytical background and econometric skills. A record of peer reviewed publications is required.

Candidates are expected to engage as economists also in interdisciplinary collaboration with the other departments of ZEF. Teaching responsibility is minor.

As the business language at ZEF is English, a good knowledge of English is required. German is desirable, but not necessary.

Experiences in designing research projects, applying for and working on third-party funded research projects is desirable.

The University of Bonn is an equal opportunity employer and places particular emphasis on fostering career opportunities for female scientists and scholars and therefore strongly encourages qualified women to apply. Disabled persons with equivalent aptitude for the position will be favored.
